

Mid-Year Economic and Fiscal Outlook



Recovery and Response Support

Since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Government has committed \$337 billion in direct economic and health support to manage the pandemic, support businesses and households during lockdowns and now secure Australia's recovery as we transition to living with COVID-19.

This fact sheet outlines the key recovery and response support measures from this MYEFO.

Economic Response

Since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Government has committed an unprecedented \$314 billion in direct economic support.

The Government's response has enabled activity and employment to bounce back strongly after restrictions have eased, maintained momentum in economic activity more broadly and prevented labour market scarring.

The economic response at this MYEFO has supported individuals, households and businesses through the Delta outbreaks. The response has built the foundation for future growth.

Health Response

The Government has taken decisive action to protect the health of Australians during the COVID-19 pandemic, committing \$23 billion to support the health system and safely reopen Australia.

This MYEFO extends a range of COVID-19 health response measures to increase the community's resilience to COVID-19 and build the health's system capability to meet current and future challenges.

The \$23 billion in COVID-19 health response does not include the full impacts of health funding committed at MYEFO. For example, measures that are not for publication (nfp) due to commercial sensitivities, such as COVID-19 Response Package vaccine and treatments purchases. It also does not include ongoing health support, including the Medicare Benefits Schedule expenditure for COVID-19 Temporary Telehealth measures.
